As believers, we have the unique opportunity to help reconcile this person to the Lord (if an unbeliever), or help restore him to a life of peace, joy and righteousness (if a believer). Just as important, we have the opportunity to enjoy an intimate relationship with our Heavenly Father as we look to *Him* for the strength and wisdom to do what is right in *His* eyes.

DON'T COVER-UP FOR THE ADDICT OR ALCOHOLIC.

DON'T GOSSIP ABOUT HIM OR HER
